Attorney for Julie Dick Law, PA

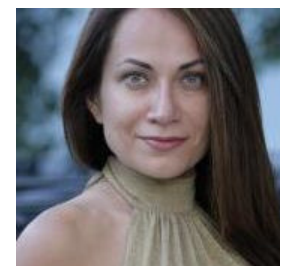
